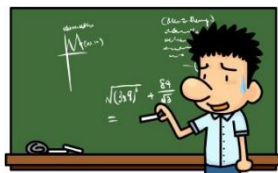

Bridge to Algebra This course is designed for students who want to sharpen their math skills in preparation for Algebra 1 (or a refresher for those going into Algebra 2).

- Extra materials needed: calculator



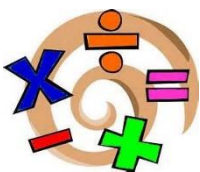
Art Elements: Basic elements of art will be taught and put into practice. Students will engage their creativity as they sketch, paint, sculpt, and design.
