Attached is a list of classes being offered, the dates and times for each class, and who will be teaching it.

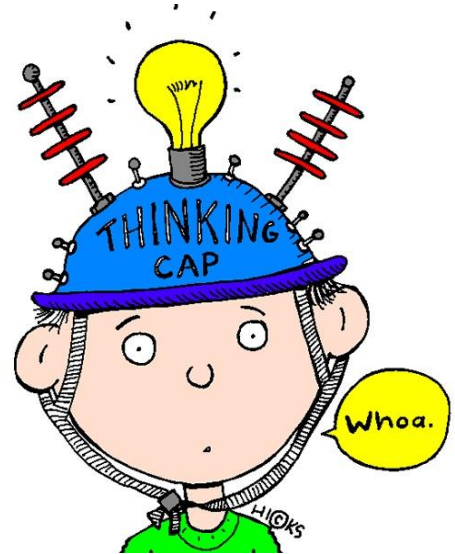
